Environment: Climate, Engagement

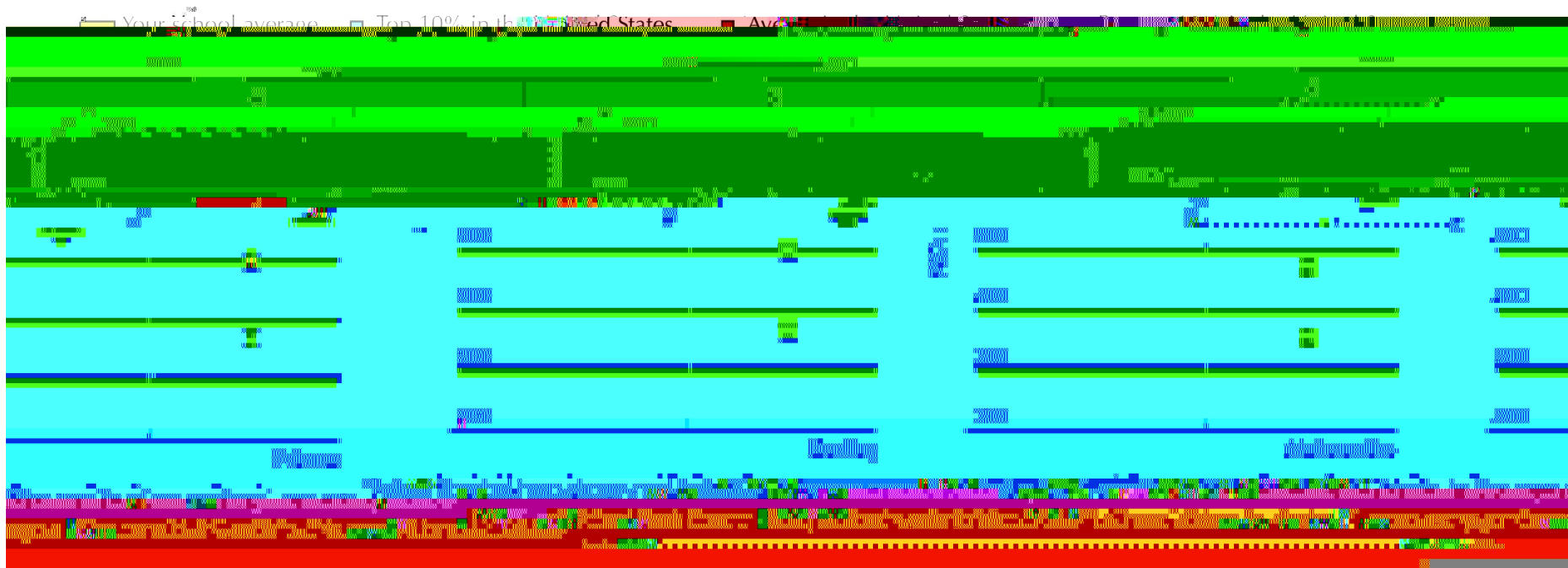

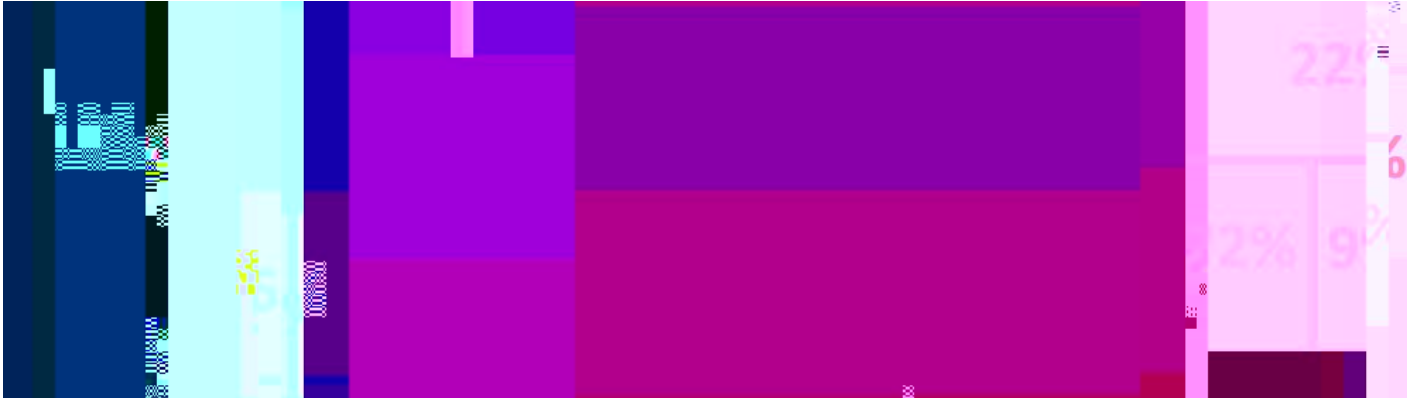
PISA comparison: 80 countries, 2015 and other years



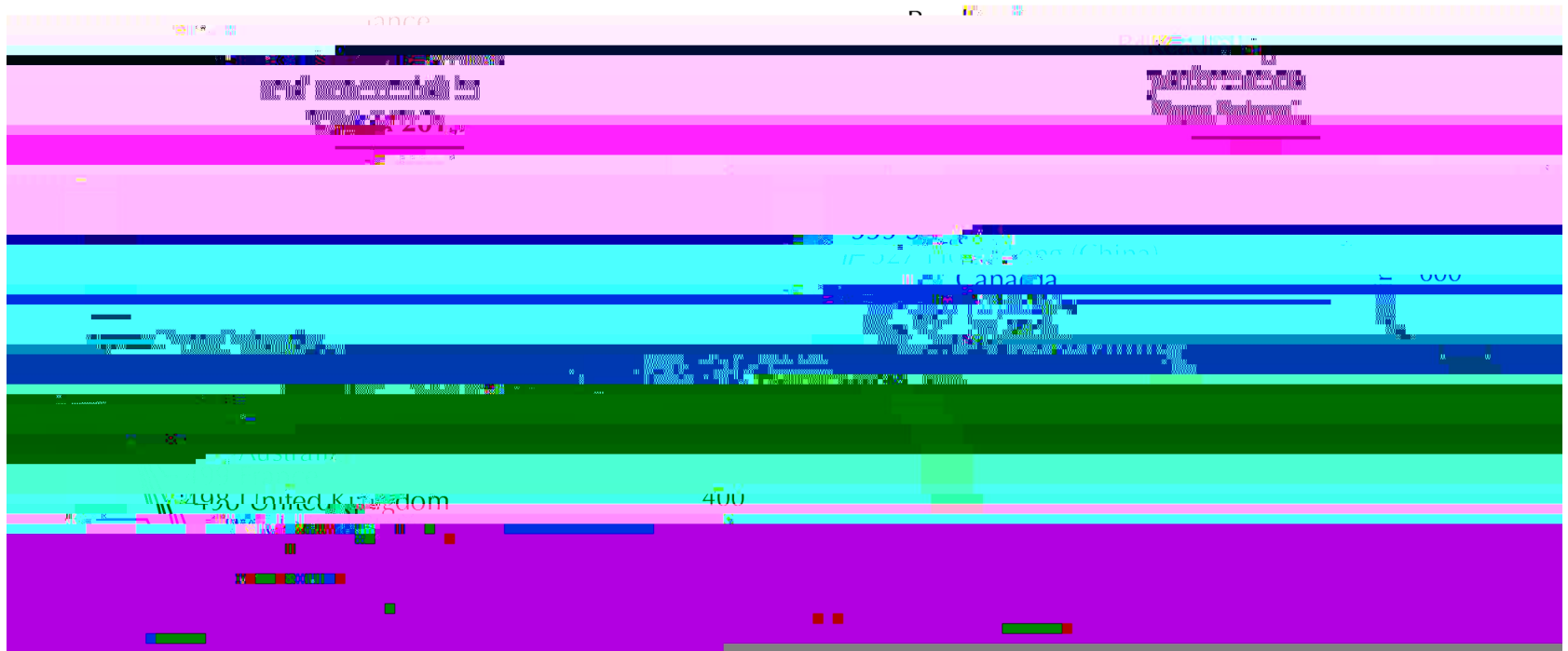
# Scale Score Overview



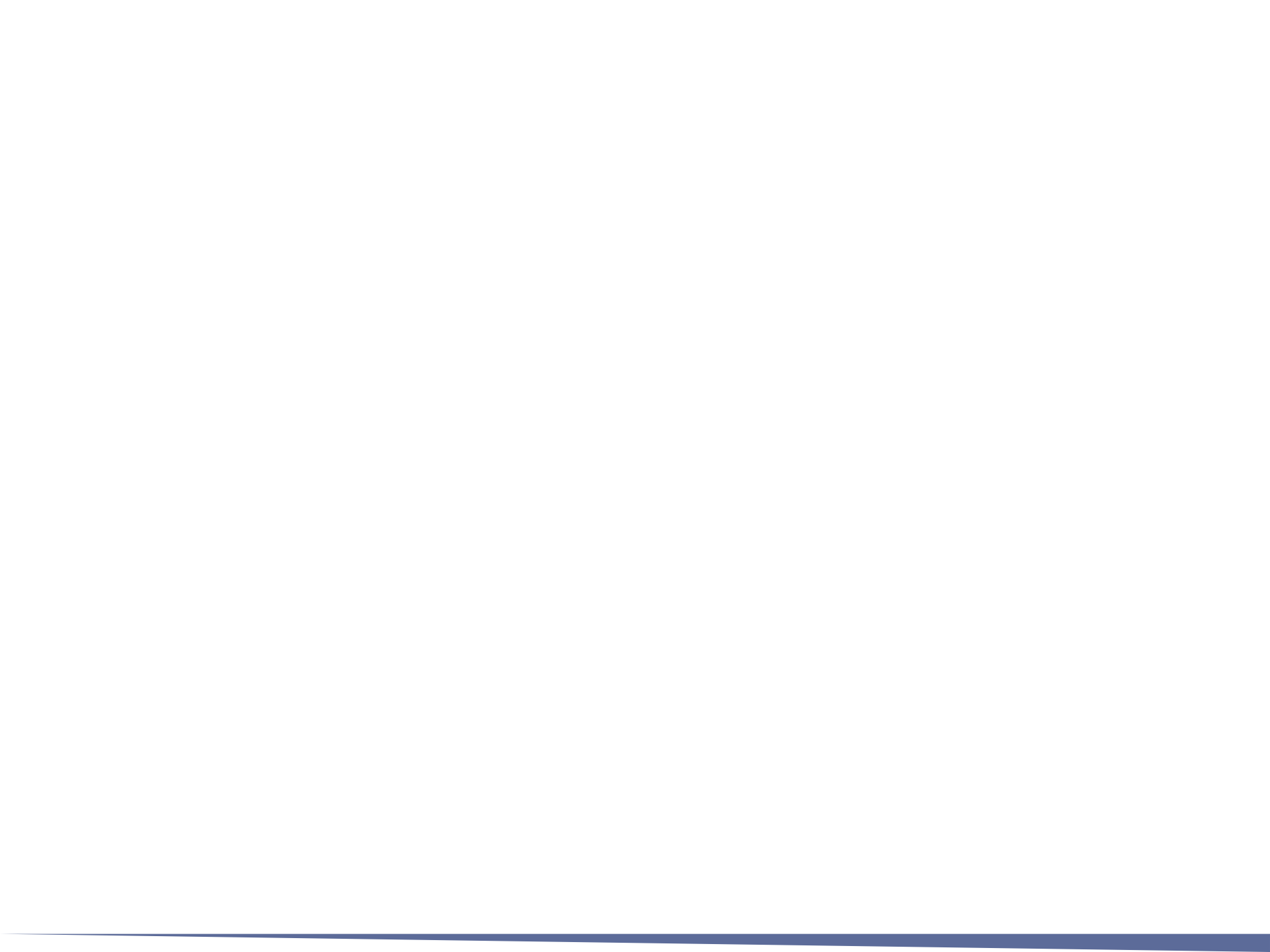
# Reading (WPS 564)

Dark = Top

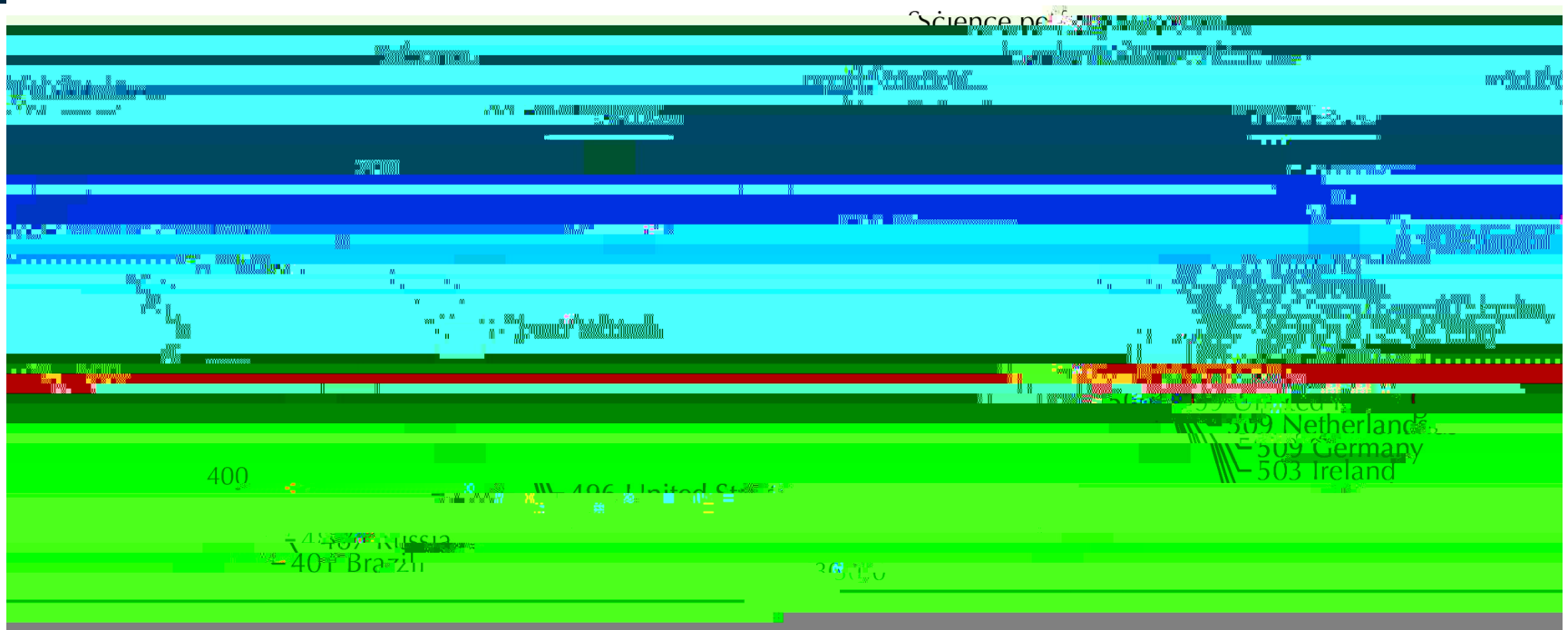


# Reader Profiles
